

Yearly Highlights

- Officers completed all mandatory In-Service training at DOCJT
- Lt. David Wiseman completed Accident Reconstruction training
Adding to our Reconstruction team consisting of Major James East, Captain Paul Campbell and Lieutenant David Wiseman
- Provided special security details on the Main Street Grand Hotel fire
- Provided Emergency Evacuation assistance with the Hazard City Schools
- Provided full services during Black Gold Festival
- Participated with ARH cancer center in the 5K run and car show raising funds that were used for fuel cards for cancer patients
- Conducted Santa with a Badge providing several families with Christmas presents for hundreds of children
- Conducted several Community Meeting with great turnouts at every event
- 2 fallen Officers that were killed in the line of duty in the early 1900's were accepted as additions to the National Monument in May 2016
- With the implementation of Tip411 in March 2015, we issued 118 community alerts consisting of road closures, crime, utility outages and weather emergencies and have received 253 tips relating to various crimes. In 2014 by comparison we received 6 tips under the old system
- Captain Paul Campbell created and launched a new version of HAZARDPD.ORG and is up and running. This new website allows easier access to various services offered.
- Lieutenant Darian Williams launched and administers Facebook and Twitter for the Hazard Police Department. We have 3,901 new followers. Lt. Williams reports the top three most viewed posts are:
 1. New Child restraint law- 60,800 views
 2. Photos of flooding- 41,100 views
 3. Aerial video of arrest of escapee from the jail- 40,300 views
